# **CCN PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER**

November 16, 2020.

To all members,

Chemawawin has now entered critical level CODE RED. This means Chemawawin has one or more ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 within Chemawawin. The following now applies:

## **Public Building Access**

- All community buildings will be shut down for public use. Staff numbers will be greatly limited.
- Deep sanitization of all community buildings will occur.
- Masks are to be worn in all public buildings.
- The Housing Department will only serve Emergent Water and Heat calls.

#### School

- The school will be closed to students.
- Home learning will start.

### **Travel (Local and Rural)**

- No entering or exiting the community unless an emergency arises.
- Local community travel is limited to the following:
  - To obtain groceries from the Grocery Store
  - To go to work if your work remains open due to urgent work
  - To do outdoor recreation with ONLY the family residing in your home (Ex: your children, grandchildren, partner.)
  - To attend an urgent appointment for medical or health service

#### **Gatherings**

- No gatherings of any form.
- No socializing outside of your immediate household family.
- No visiting other households.

## **Grocery Access**

- The grocery store will limit shoppers to 5 at a time.
- The store will begin taking grocery phone orders for curbside pick-up and delivery.
- You can order online from your favorite stores and have the items shipped/ delivered to Chemawawin.

## **COVID Response**

- The COVID Response Team will work to trace all cases to ensure all community members potentially affected are made aware and given proper instructions for self quarantining or seeking medical help.
- CODE RED will remain until COVID infections are contained and the spread in Chemawawin is contained.
- Once all COVID cases are contained and managed Chemawawin will re-enter CODE ORANGE.

#### **Personal Protection**

- Wear a mask when around anyone from outside your own household.
- Only see those living within your household.
- Wash hands frequently, especially when re-entering your home.
- Stay home.
- Only make essential community trips for groceries.

If you develop symptoms of COVID-19 you must call the Nursing Station immediately to book an appointment to be tested for COVID-19 by the Nursing Team. Once you have an appointment time, drive to the Nursing Station where you will be tested once it is your appointment time.
